EVENT DESCRIPTION

Educators are our greatest champions! EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Interview Day will take place during Round 1 of the apprenticeship portal and will allow you to condense interviews into one day's time by coordinating with applicants who you believe would be a good fit for your company.

BUSINESS COMMITMENT

Communicate with applicants you are interested in interviewing and coordinate a time slot during the interview day. We ask you send at least two staff members to this event. This will allow for at least one staff member to interview students during their slotted time and other staff members to speak with other students about your company's apprenticeship opportunity.
